

### CONDITIONS OF BOOKING

**Payment:**

1. No booking can be regarded as confirmed until the completed booking form and payment have been returned to us.

**Cancellation:**

2. In the event of cancellation of the booking, every effort will be made to fill the places, and, if successful, the fees will be returned. If unsuccessful, any cancellations after monies have been paid will be charged as follows:

Prior to six weeks of commencement date:	Deposit
4-6 weeks of commencement date:	70% of total sum
Less than 4 weeks of commencement date:	No refund

The date of cancellation is the date of the receipt of WRITTEN cancellation at Mylor Sailing School's office.

3. We reserve the right to cancel any of our courses due to operational reasons. In this event all fees will be refunded unless alternative dates are acceptable.
4. We can accept no responsibility for the effect that weather conditions may have on our programme. In the event of severe weather forcing cancellation for safety reasons you will be given the option of alternative dates subject to availability. We regret that we cannot refund course fees.

**Severe Weather Indemnity:**

5. In view of section 4 above, we offer you the opportunity to take out our "Severe Weather Indemnity", in which case your course fees will be refunded for the time lost (less indemnity fee - see booking form).

The decision whether or not to sail is always the responsibility of the Senior Instructor on duty at the time.

**Safety:**

6. All participants should be able to swim.
7. Anyone who, in the opinion of the Senior Instructor, is unfit for any activity, or who behaves in such a way likely to cause danger, or spoil the enjoyment of other members of any group, may be excluded from taking part.

**Lost property:**

8. We remind everyone to take all their possessions home with them. We will keep lost property until the end of the season, but regret that we cannot forward items by post.

**Insurance:**

9. Our boats and staff are covered by a public liability insurance policy. We accept no liability for personal accident, or loss of your property.

**You will need to bring:**

**Clothing:**

Plenty of warm old clothes. Several thin layers are better than one or two thick ones. Track suit trousers / leggings are better than jeans, which are heavy & uncomfortable when wet. You will also need light waterproofs, and non slip soled shoes such as plimsolls or trainers.

**Bring a towel, and change of clothes.**

Sun screen & hat are advisable in hot and sunny weather, and gloves & warm hat will make things more comfortable during the colder months.

Buoyancy aids are provided.

**Lunches:**

For full day activities you should bring a packed lunch & drink as required.
